Apple varieties available for grafting are Arkansas Black, Black Twig, Cox's Orange Pippin, Grimes Golden, Smokehouse, Ralls, Virginia Beauty, Virginia (Hewes) Crab & Winesap. Handouts on dormant wood grafting will be provided. **Bring hand pruners with you.**

A professional grafting knife is **included** with your registration. Knife sharpening will be demonstrated. Extra rootstocks and scionwood will be available for purchase.
